Rector's Letter March 2020



On the front of the Church Easter card this year is a picture of the cross surrounded by primroses, symbols of new life and resurrection.

Primroses are a sure sign that spring is on the way, with the name primrose being derived from the Latin *prima rosa* meaning "first rose". Primroses flower from February to May and are sometimes called Lent or Easter roses, they are also popular as gifts for Mothering Sunday, which this year is on Sunday 22nd March. Do join us for a service of Morning Prayer (hymns, prayers, readings and sermon, no Communion) in church at 10am when we will give thanks for our mothers and those who have been like a mother to us.

The primrose is native to Britain and is a hardy perennial, meaning it will grow year after year and will spread naturally or if divided. Various meanings are attached to the primrose but the ones I like best are that of love and purity, making it the ideal backdrop for the symbol of the cross.

The whole month of March this year is taken up with the season of Lent, which began on Ash Wednesday, 26th February and while Lent is a solemn time, in preparation for Holy Week and the death of Jesus, all around us, in nature, there are signs of new life, which for Christians is ultimately seen on Easter Day, the day Jesus rose from the dead, in order to bring new life to all who believe in Him.

There are several special services during Holy Week, all of which are detailed in the Easter Card, please do feel free to join us, or contact me for further information and do join us on Easter Day Sunday 12th April at 10am when we will celebrate once again the gift of new life won for us all through the cross of Christ.

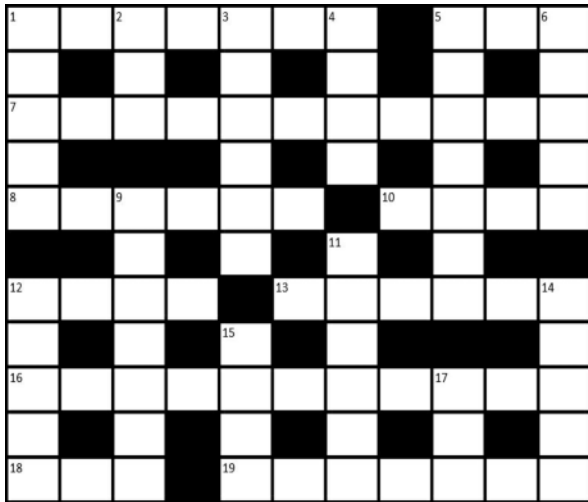
